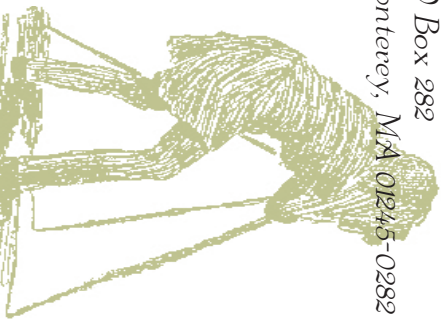

# Monterey Photo Contest & Exhibition

The Monterey Cultural Council presents a juried Photo Contest and Exhibition, to be held Labor Day Weekend, **September 4 - 7, 2009**, in the basement of the Monterey Church. The Jury of Awards will select winners from various categories determined by the Cultural Council. Winners will receive certificates; there will be no cash or merchandise prizes. Entries may be used for Town of Monterey publicity, e.g., on the Town's website.

The contest is open to all photographers of all ages, amateur and professional; works may be in any photographic style or medium. There is no entrance fee.

**All photos must have been taken in Monterey, Massachusetts.** Photos may be recent or historic. Subject matter may be landscape, people, animals, buildings, nature—anything you feel in some way portrays some aspect of Monterey.

Each entrant must fill out an application; each photo must be identified with title, location, approximate date, price (if any), and the artists' name and phone number.

Photos must be ready to hang, preferably framed, but neat mounting and hanger are acceptable. Maximum size in any direction (including mat and frame) should be 30 inches. Each artist may enter up to three photos. At least one photo by each entrant will be displayed, at the discretion of the MCC.

All entrants give the Town of Monterey the right to reproduce images for promotional purposes. Every effort will be taken to safeguard the art work; but by entering the contest, the artist exempts the Town of Monterey, the Monterey Cultural Council, and all individuals involved, from any liability regarding harm to or loss of work.

Work can be offered for sale. Please indicate price on both the application and the back of the photo. Twenty percent of the sale price will go to the Monterey Cultural Council for future programs.
