

Minutes June 11, 1990

Members Present Conrad Ohman, Ellen Pearson, Fred Vorck, Arthur Hastedt. John Piretti was ill. Members Absent Jed Lipsky, Raymond Tryon.

It was decided that the CC would have copies of the Lake Garfield Study made instead of contacting the BOS or the company that did the study. This seemed to be the easiest and most direct way to obtain copies. The secretary was directed to have 7 copies made for the commissioners.

The meeting in July will be on the third Monday, July 16, 1990 and not on July 9, 1990 as regularly scheduled. If Fred Vorck is unavailable on the 16th he will not be listed as absent in the minutes.

Susan Sellow explained about her barn project. The pole barn is to be located 85' from Rawson Brooke. The only alteration of the buffer zone will be from the holes dug for the poles. The commission felt the project was non-significant and the Building Inspector will be instructed to issue the Building Permit.

David McAllester sent a sketch of a dock he plans to build on his property. The dock is removable and water is able to pass freely under the structure. The commission agreed that it is a non significant project.

Nathan Ron has hire Accord Engineers. The engineers contacted Connie, while they have started they would not be able to complete a filing in time for this meeting. They will proceed and file as soon as possible.

Stevens Lake

The work on the dam has been completed. He will begin the water samples on June 15, Connie will get a test sample on Wednesday. Yost had inquired if he had to have all the test done that had been required of him by the commission. The commission felt he did need to have them done.

The commission discussed the requirements in order to dredge in the canal in front of the cottage belonging to Herb Burke (Broderick RD.)
