Section 4. Speed Restrictions

- a) No person shall operate a motorboat or personal water craft, as defined under M.G.L. Chapter 90B, at speeds greater than 10 m.p.h. while passing through the channel between the large and small sections of Lake Garfield, and to enforce this regulation via the placement of buoy markers at each end of the channel which shall designate the speed limit within.
- b) No person shall operate a motorboat while towing a person on water-skis, or while barefoot skiing, or in any manner on that portion of Lake Garfield west of the channel.
- c) Penalty: \$20 to \$50.

Enforcement of these bylaws shall be conducted by local and state law enforcement officers, Harbormasters, or other town officials designated and authorized by the Select Board.
