Several months ago, I wrote a short piece for the Monterey News suggesting ways in which “democracy” could be enhanced in the Town. A few of my suggestions were intended to encourage more volunteers either to run for some public office or be appointed to certain public positions. This was proposed as a rewarding endeavor. Unfortunately, my own recent experience volunteering has not worked out the way I had envisioned which is both discouraging and disquieting.

Effective immediately, I am resigning my position as a member of the Monterey Conservation Commission.

Monterey is a wonderful Town in which to live. However, the obstacles and lack of support in effectively conducting the responsibilities and obligations of the Conservation Commission have, in my view, surpassed the Commission’s capacity to do the necessary work in an efficient and professional manner. I don’t think that it is helpful at this point to specify all the obstacles which I believe have been documented and are available in the Commission’s minutes.
