Greetings:

        In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn inhabitants of said Town qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet in the Firehouse of the Monterey Fire Company Ltd. in said Town on Friday, June 30, 2017, at 7 o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on the following articles:

**ARTICLE 1.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$60,150 or any other sum from Free Cash to pay for the FY17 transfer station loan payment, or take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE 2.** To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the additional sum of \$15,548 or any other sum for the FY18 loan and interest on the fire truck, or take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE 3.** To see if the Town will vote to approve the Southern Berkshire Regional School District Capital Budget for FY2018 and vote to raise and appropriate \$47,051 or any other sum to pay for the Town's assessed share of that budget, or take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE 6.** To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$6,954.01 or any other sum from free cash, \$421.45 to 015151.700 Town Counsel Expenses, \$90.03 to 015158.000 Printing Expenses, \$5,735.57 to 015220.100 Fire Calls, \$702.96 to 015424.700 Public Lighting and \$4 to 015220.703 Fire Dept Utilities & Facilities Rental, or take any other action relative thereto.
