To: Raymond W. Tryon, Constable of the Town of Monterey in the County of Berkshire,
Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn inhabitants of said Town qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet in the Firehouse of the Monterey Fire Company Ltd. in said Town on Thursday, March 2, 2017, at 7 o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$7,120 or any other sum from the special article to paint town hall approved at the May 5, 2012 annual town meeting to a new account to repair/renovate town hall, or take any other action relative thereto.

The Finance Committee supports approving this article.

ARTICLE 2. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$1,500 or any other sum from the Town Administrator Salary line item to a new account to pay for Town Administrator expenses, or take any other action relative thereto.

The Finance Committee supports approving this article.

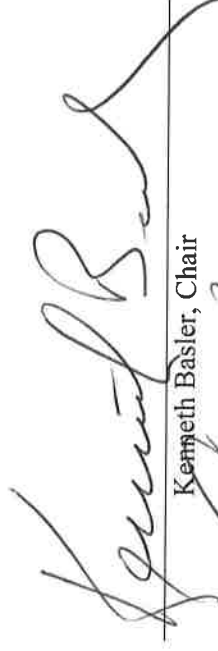
ARTICLE 3. To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$20,000 or any other sum from free cash to a new contingency fund for the Community Development Block Grant, or take any other action relative thereto.

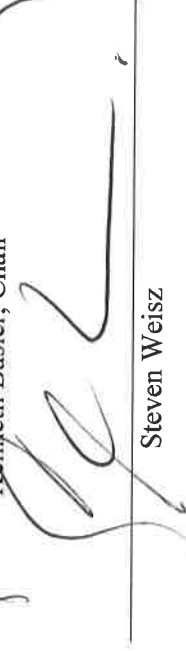
The Finance Committee supports approving this article.
